Des Moines University invites applications and nominations for the position of President of the University. Founded in 1898, Des Moines University comprises three colleges; College of Osteopathic Medicine, College of Podiatric Medicine & Surgery, and the College of Health Sciences. DMU seeks an energetic, visionary and entrepreneurial leader with a collaborative style to enhance and further the academic programs of the University; support faculty and staff development and aspirations; and relate to over 1700 hard-working and engaged graduate students and 10,500 active and dedicated alumni. The position is available no later than July 1, 2011.

DMU is the second oldest osteopathic school in the country; one of the top 20 medical schools (for D.O.s or M.D.s) in the nation and the largest medical school in Iowa; large enough to offer every educational amenity but small enough to focus on excellence.
