East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania (ESU) invites applications and nominations for the position of President, with the goal of having the new President in place by July 1, 2012.

Located in northeastern Pennsylvania, the university is one of the 14 institutions in the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education and within two hours of New York City and Philadelphia. The university has 66 buildings located on approximately 256 acres in East Stroudsburg Borough and in Smithfield Township. The university faculty totals 321, while another 410 employees make up the management and non-instructional staff. Faculty members are representative of many and varied institutions of higher education in both the United States and abroad. The terminal degree is held by 77 percent of the instructional faculty. ESU serves over 6600 undergraduate and 649 graduate students in a student centered environment.
