The Board of Trustees invites nominations and applications for the position of president of Goddard College.

Goddard has a proud history of transforming the lives of its students through its unwavering devotion to the principles of progressive education, creating innovations now widely adopted throughout higher education. The College seeks a collaborative leader who will work with the Goddard community to improve the delivery and pedagogy of high quality education. Goddard's history and philosophy of responsible experimentation has positioned the College for growth and further innovation. Goddard has no long-term debt. The resulting opportunity for leadership in higher education will be attractive to a creative, accessible, educator/resource developer/administrator.

Today, the College enrolls 760 adult learners (60% graduate, 40% undergraduate) who participate with committed faculty advisors in a student centered, individualized approach to learning. The low residency model of higher education, pioneered at Goddard, brings students and faculty to campuses in Plainfield, VT and Port Townsend, WA for intensive eight-day residencies. When not in residence, students continue to work on projects under the guidance of their advisors.

The new president will take office in Plainfield, VT on or about July 1, 2010. The presidential search committee will begin a review of candidates in October and will begin to narrow the pool in late November. The committee will continue to receive applications until an appointment is made.
