



**Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana - Indianapolis  
Chancellor**

The Board of Trustees of Ivy Tech Community College - Indianapolis announces the search for Chancellor. The successful candidate will lead a thriving institution with a \$57 million budget and record enrollment of 25,000 in one of America's most desirable metropolitan areas.

The main campus is in downtown Indianapolis ([www.visitindy.com](http://www.visitindy.com)), America's 13<sup>th</sup> largest city, which boasts a robust economy, a vibrant downtown, and a highly cosmopolitan lifestyle. Ranked as one of the best places in America to live, this growing area serves a population of 1.6 million. The vigorous Indianapolis educational community, including IUPUI, provides rich opportunities for Ivy Tech students seeking further academic and professional growth.

In addition to Indianapolis, this region includes a full-service campus in suburban Lawrence and 11 delivery sites for instruction in eight counties [www.ivytech.edu/indianapolis](http://www.ivytech.edu/indianapolis). There are 38 associate degree programs with 52 concentrations in eight schools. Enrollment has increased 25 percent since 2008, and campus expansion is keeping pace with rapid growth, including a 200,000 sq. ft. project that is now under way.

Ivy Tech Community College ([www.ivytech.edu](http://www.ivytech.edu)) is the nation's largest statewide community college with a single accreditation, and Ivy Tech Central Indiana (Indianapolis) is the largest region in the system. The state's leading provider of workforce training, Ivy Tech prepares Indiana residents to learn, live, and work in a diverse and globally-competitive environment by delivering professional technical, transfer, and lifelong education.

The next Chancellor will serve on the President's cabinet and will play a pivotal role in implementing the new statewide strategic plan, "Accelerating Greatness 2013" <http://www.ivytech.edu/about/StrategicPlan2013.pdf> in the Indianapolis region. Ivy Tech has been selected by the Lumina Foundation as one of only 100 institutions in the U.S. to participate in the "Achieving the Dream" initiative [www.achievingthedream.org](http://www.achievingthedream.org), which focuses on the best practices to ensure student success through degree completion. This strategy is also an important component of the Indiana Higher Education Commission's "Reaching Higher" [www.in.gov/che](http://www.in.gov/che) plan that moves Indiana institutions of higher education from an enrollment-growth focus to an outcome-based model that stresses higher completion rates. These three documents comprise the touchstones of Ivy Tech's strategic direction in the near future.

The Search Committee seeks candidates with a well established record of academic, business or professional achievement; history of increasingly responsible administrative positions; impeccable leadership qualities; and proven fundraising skills. Earned doctorate and/or community college experience preferred but not required. Strong organizational and communication abilities, a talent for confident decision-making, and a record of success in building and sustaining effective public/private partnerships (including K-12 schools) are essential.
