



Peace College, a distinctive undergraduate college for women, invites expressions of interest from women and men in this opportunity for engaged and energetic presidential leadership. The appointment of Peace's tenth president will become effective on or about July 1, 2010. The beautiful and historic 21-acre Peace campus enrolls 700 students and is located in the heart of the capital city of Raleigh, North Carolina, one of the fastest growing cities in the nation.

Founded in 1857 in affiliation with the Presbyterian Church, Peace was initially a preparatory institute and later evolved as a junior college for women. In the last decade, the College has become known for its baccalaureate liberal arts curriculum with a required internship component that encourages connections, collaborative problem solving, and the maintenance of a strong student/faculty community to foster learning. Recently, Peace initiated an evening program that is open to men. Since awarding its first baccalaureate degree in 1996, Peace College has grown significantly in enrollment, staff, program array, and budget, and has invested over \$23 million in its campus facilities.

Peace has consistently ranked in the top ten percent of National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) categories of student-faculty interaction, supportive campus environment, active and collaborative learning, and enriching educational experiences. This recognition reflects the importance of a student-centered education at Peace, and underscores a dedicated faculty's commitment to facilitate student growth and academic achievement

Peace College's next president will be asked to build on these achievements and to shape an ambitious vision for continued accomplishment and ongoing growth. Experience with strategic planning, enrollment management, philanthropic development, and financial management will all be important, as will leadership skills that inspire all constituencies to collaborate in the further development of a creative vision and a sound plan for the future.
