

# CHANCELLOR



The University of Wisconsin System invites applications and nominations for the position of Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. Founded in 1866, UW-Platteville seeks an energetic, visionary and entrepreneurial leader with a collaborative style to enhance and further the academic programs of the University; support faculty and staff development and aspirations; and relate to over 7000 hard-working and engaged students. The position is available on July 1, 2010.

Platteville and its supporting communities, with a population approximating 12,000 people, are located in the scenic, driftless area of southwestern Wisconsin. Platteville is located 70 miles southwest of Madison, 150 miles west of Milwaukee and 25 miles northeast of Dubuque, Iowa.

Students attending UW-Platteville are from all parts of Wisconsin, from surrounding states and from other countries. UW-Platteville's fall 2009 students enrollment is 7100 on-campus students (6700 undergraduates and 400 graduate students), in addition to 2200 students at a distance. The University includes approximately 925 employees (full-time and part-time, exclusive of students), with 360 faculty and instructional staff members.

The Chancellor serves as the chief executive officer of the University and reports to the System President and the State Board of Regents. The successful candidate will be an institutional leader, both internally and externally, as well as an entrepreneurial visionary who can build on past successes while leading the institution to new achievements. UW-Platteville seeks a leader with a strong commitment to academic excellence and racial, ethnic, and cultural diversity; the ability to raise funds in support of academic programs, scholarships, strategic initiatives and endowment; a proven record of community and national leadership; and the ability to build partnerships on behalf of the institution.
